**ORDER PRELIMINARILY APPROVING DISTRIBUTION PLAN
FOR SETTLEMENT WITH KELLER WILLIAMS REALTY, LLC**

Plaintiffs Mya Batton, Aaron Bolton, Michael Brace, Do Yeon Kim, Anna James, James Mullis, Theodore Bisbicos, and Daniel Parsons (collectively, “Plaintiffs”), moved this Court for an order preliminarily approving the proposed Distribution Plan for their class action settlement with Keller Williams Realty, LLC fna Keller Williams Realty, Inc (“Keller Williams”). The Court hereby enters the following Order, having read and considered the Stipulation and Agreement of Settlement with Keller Williams Realty, LLC (ECF No. 262-2) (“Settlement Agreement”), Plaintiffs’ Motion for Preliminary Approval of the Proposed Distribution Plan for Settlement with Keller Williams (“Motion”) (ECF No. 276), and accompanying documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, on this 12th day of March 2026, upon the application of the Parties,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Except for the terms expressly defined herein, the Court adopts and incorporates the definitions in the Settlement Agreement and in Plaintiffs' Motion for the purposes of this Order.
2. The proposed Distribution Plan set forth in Exhibit A to the Joint Declaration of Vincent Briganti and Randall Ewing dated February 26, 2026, is reasonable and rational and is therefore preliminarily approved.
3. The proposed Distribution Plan shall be posted to the Settlement Website for Settlement Class Members to review in connection with the issuance of Notice or as soon thereafter as is practicable.
